Chap 84.

An act to restore the name and rights of Prairieville academy.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Act restored. SECTION 1. The act entitled "an act to incorporate the trustees of the Prairieville academy," approved February 19th, 1841, as amended by an act entitled "an act to amend an act to incorporate the trustees of Prairieville academy," approved January 27th, 1844, is hereby restored.

Trustees continued. SEC. 2. The trustees of said academy, at the time of the passage of the act of January 31st, 1846, entitled "an act to incorporate Carroll college," are hereby made and continued trustees of said academy, until others shall be elected and qualified, as hereinafter provided.

To call meeting. SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the said trustees to call a meeting of the stockholders of said academy, on the first Monday of May next, in the village of Waukesha, to elect a new board of trustees of said academy, and to give notice of such meeting by publishing the same in the "Waukesha Democrat," four successive weeks immediately preceding such election: and at such meeting the stockholders shall have power to elect such trustees in the manner provided by law.

To enjoy all powers, and subject to all liabilities. SEC. 4. The trustees of said academy shall be restored to, and shall have and enjoy all the rights, property and powers, and shall be subject to the same duties and liabilities as were possessed and enjoyed, conferred or imposed under and by the act of incorporation and the act amendatory thereto, recited in the first section of this act; and suits at law or in equity on all contracts entered into by and with the trustees of said academy previous to the said act of January 31st, 1846, may be brought and maintained by or against the trustees of said academy, in the same manner and with like effect, as though the said act of January 31st, 1846, had never been passed.

May sell buildings. SEC. 5. The trustees of said academy, who shall be elected as is provided in the third section of this act, are hereby authorized and empowered to give, grant, or sell and convey the buildings and other property, belonging to said corporation to the state for the purpose of using the same for the establishment of a normal school at Waukesha.

SEC. 6. Nothing in this act shall be so construed as to take away the name of Carroll college, or to affect in any manner the rights of the trustees of Carroll college conferred by an act entitled

"an act to incorporate Carroll college," approved January 31st, 1846.

SEC. 7. Nothing in this act shall be so construed as to give the trustees power to collect subscriptions heretofore made for stock in said academy.

An act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Merchant's Mutual Insurance Company of Milwaukee."

Chap. 85.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The twelfth section of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Merchants' Mutual Insurance Company, approved February 10, 1847, is hereby amended by striking out the words "at the expiration of one year from the time the first policy shall have been issued and bears date, and within one month thereafter, and during the first month after the expiration of every subsequent year," in the first, second, third, and fourth lines of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof, "on the first Monday of February, 1850, and annually thereafter," and to further amend by striking out the word "year," in the seventh line, and in lieu thereof insert "period since the date of the first policy issued."

Amendment.

SEC. 2. The thirtieth section of said act is hereby amended by striking out of the first, second, third, and fourth lines the words "first month after the expiration of the first year from the time the said company shall issue their first policy and within the first month of every subsequent year, and inserting in lieu thereof "month of February in each year."
