An Act appropriating money to the County of Brown.

Chap 258

*The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the county of Brown, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and twenty-four dollars and one cent, in full for money appropriated by said county of Brown, to the payment of the expenses to which said county had been subjected on account of keeping Alexander McCarty, a state prisoner confined within the jail of said county, and retaking said McCarty after an escape.
