## Chap. 83.

AN ACT to appropriate to Daniel H. Chandler the sum therein named.

Published, May 6, 1854.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

§ 1. The state treasurer is hereby authorized to pay to Daniel H. Chandler, the late reporter of the decisions of the supreme court, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three hundred dollars, in full compensation and satisfaction for one hundred volumes of the decisions of the late supreme court, being volume four of such decisions, for the year eighteen hundred and fifty-two; but such payment shall not be made until one hundred bound copies shall be delivered to the governor or to the secretary of state, for the state of Wisconsin, in conformity with title eight, chapter twenty-two, of the revised statutes.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately after the compliance with the provisions thereof.
