CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT to change the time for holding the circuit court in the sixth judicial circuit.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Time of holding courts.

SECTION 1. The circuit court in the following named counties in the sixth judicial circuit of the state of Wisconsin shall be holden at the times hereinafter mentioned, instead of the times now provided by law, viz : in the county of Clark, on the first Monday of September and the third Monday of May, of each year ; in the county of Jackson, on the second Monday of September and the fourth Monday of May, of each year ; in the county of Buffalo, on the second Monday of October and the second Monday of April, of each year ; in the county of Monroe, on the third Monday of October and the third Monday of April, of each year ; in the county of Bad Ax, on the fourth Monday of October and the first Monday of May, of each year ; in the county of La Crosse, on the second Monday of November and the second Monday of March, of each year ; and in the county of Trempeleau, on the first Monday of December and the first Monday of March, of each year.

Process, &c. returnable.

SEC. 2. All process, proceedings, and recognizances heretofore commenced, issued or taken, or which may be commenced, issued, or taken in or from said courts or either of them, and all proceedings pending therein or returnable thereto, whether by recognizance or otherwise, shall be held and taken as returnable at the times named in this act as the times for holding the said courts respectively.

Take effect.

SEC. 3. All acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed ; and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of July next.
