

## CHAPTER 52.

[Published February 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend subdivision three, section forty-five, chapter twenty-three, of Revised Statutes, entitled "Of common schools."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amendment  
to section 45,  
chap. 23, R. S.

SECTION 1. Subdivision three, of section forty-five, of chapter twenty-three, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of common schools," is hereby amended, by inserting the word "raised," after the word "moneys," where it last occurs in said subdivision three.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 53.

[Published February 29, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter twenty-two, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act relative to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the conveyance and redemption thereof."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amendment  
to law of 1859,  
in ref. to tax  
sales.

SECTION 1. Section four (4), of chapter twenty-two (22), of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act relative to sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the conveyance and redemption thereof," is hereby amended, by striking out the words "first day of February," where they occur in the third line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "last Monday of January."

Lands bid off

SEC. 2. Section ten (10), of the act of which this is amendatory, is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "Section 10. All lands bid off for the county, as provided in the preceding section, shall continue liable to be taxed, in the same manner as if they were the property of individuals, and in like manner shall be advertised and sold for the unpaid taxes, interest and charges due thereon; but the county shall continue to be the exclusive purchaser thereof, until the same shall have been re-
