

CHAPTER 73.

[Published March 5, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize the issuing of patents to deceased persons in certain cases.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

PATENT FOR LANDS SHALL INURE TO HEIRS OF DECEASED PERSON.

SECTION 1. In all cases where patents for lands, belonging to the State of Wisconsin, have been, or may hereafter be, issued, in pursuance of any law of this State, to a person who had died, or who shall hereafter die, before the date of such patent, the title to the land designated therein, shall inure to and become vested in the heirs, devisees or assignees of such deceased patentee, as if the patent had issued to the deceased person during life.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 74.

[Published March 5, 1860.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Union, in the county of Rock.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Time extended. Proviso

SECTION 1. The time by law for collecting taxes, and the return thereof, by the treasurer of the town of Union, in the county of Rock, is hereby extended to the first day of April next: *Provided*, that nothing in this act shall be so construed as to make any change in the time for paying over the State or county tax

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from its passage.
