CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT to change the name of Lucy Bell, and to establish her guardianship and heirship.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That Lucy Bell, now living in the family of James Jones, in the county of Grant, be adopted into the family of said James Jones, and Martha his wife, with all the rights of support, education and inheritance, and all the duties of obedience, which would pertain to the said Lucy, had she been born of her adopted parents in lawful wedlock: *Provided*, That the said James and Martha Jones shall, within ninety days after the passage of this act, file in the office of the clerk of the circuit court, of said county of Grant, a written acceptance of the terms and provisions of this act; and such acceptance, so filed, shall be binding, for all purposes, upon the said James Jones and Martha his wife.

Lucy Bell adopted as child of James Jones and wife.

Proviso, as to acceptance by said Jones.

§ 2. Neither the natural father nor mother of the said Lucy shall have any right to her custody, or any right to the property of the said Lucy, by inheritance or otherwise.

Natural parents divested of rights.

§ 3. The name of the said Lucy Bell is hereby changed into that of Lucy Jones.

Name changed.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Prescott," approved March 9, 1857.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The charter elections of said city shall be held on the first Tuesday of April in each year.

Time of election.

§ 2. Insert after the words "police justice," in the second line of section first, of chapter second, of said act, "superintendent of schools."

Amendment to charter.

§ 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
