

receive pay at the rates allowed privates by the United States for military services, for the time he was in actual service: *provided*, that it shall be made to appear to the governor that he had enlisted with the *bona fide* intention of being mustered into the service of the United States. Proviso.

SECTION 2. The commanding officers of such companies shall furnish to the adjutant general a full and accurate muster roll of the men entitled to pay under this act, certified under oath by them to be correct; a copy of which, approved by the adjutant general, shall be filed with the secretary of state, as the pay roll under this act, on which the secretary of state shall issue warrants to each person therein named, for the sum reported by the adjutant general to be due. Muster rolls to be furnished adjutant general, &c.

SECTION 3. The muster rolls and vouchers required to be furnished by this act, shall be prepared and filed by the adjutant general with the secretary of state, within thirty days from the passage of this act. Muster rolls to be filed.

SECTION 4. All moneys paid out and expended under the provisions of this act, shall be drawn from and paid out of the war fund in the treasury of this state; and there is hereby appropriated out of said fund, not otherwise appropriated, a sum of money sufficient to make all payments and defray all expenditures under this act. Moneys to be drawn from the war fund.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT to provide for the expenses of this Special Session of the Legislature.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All expenses connected with the special session of the legislature, which convened on the 15th day of May, 1861, shall be chargeable to the war fund; To be paid from the war fund.

and a sufficient amount is appropriated from said fund to pay such expenditures.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 11.

[Published May 27, 1861.]

AN ACT to amend Section five of Chapter four of the General Laws of 1861, Extra Session, entitled "An act to provide a military force for immediate service to aid in protecting and defending the Constitution and the Union."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Pay of officers after having been mustered into service three months.

SECTION 1. Section five of chapter four of the general laws of 1861, extra session, entitled "An act to provide a military force for immediate service to aid in protecting and defending the constitution and the union," is hereby amended by inserting after the word "provided" where it last occurs in said section, the words "after having been mustered into the service of the state three months."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend "An act to provide for the purchasing of arms and equipments for the State," approved May 25th, 1861.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
