

CHAPTER 5.

[Published January 28, 1862.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Beloit.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes in the town of Beloit, in the county of Rock, is hereby extended till the first Monday in April, 1862: *provided*, that this act shall not be so construed as to extend the time for the payment of state taxes. Extended to April 1.

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said town shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said town tax roll, after as before such extension of time for the collection of said taxes, and the return of the town treasurer to the county treasurer within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid as if made pursuant to the direction of the original warrant. Authority to treasurer—his return.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT for the relief of the several towns, cities and villages of the county of Fond du Lac.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The county treasurer of the county of Fond du Lac is hereby authorized and required to receive from the treasurers of the several towns, cities and villages of said county, in payment of county taxes for the year 1861, all county orders issued to the several towns, cities and wards in said county, during the session of the county board of supervisors of said coun- County orders receivable for taxes of 1861.
