SECTION 2. Section two of the act to which this is amendatory, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 210.

[Published April 17, 1863.]

AN ACT to vacate certain portions of the village plat of Fox Lake.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Portions vacated.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted, That all that part of the south-west quarter of the south-east quarter of section twenty-six, and of the west half of the north-east quarter of section thirty-five, in township thirteen, range thirteen, that is plotted and known as "Thomas and Germain's addition to Fox Lake," in Dodge county, except lots one, two and three, block one, and lots eight, eleven, twelve, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and nineteen, in block two, be and the same is [are] hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
