

## CHAPTER 250.

[Published April 15, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize Ellwood Loy, a minor, to transact business.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Ellwood Loy, (aged 20 years, November, 1863,) a minor son of David M. Loy, of the village of Depere, in the county of Brown, state of Wisconsin, is hereby authorized and empowered to grant, bargain, sell and convey real and personal estate and property, transact business and bind himself by his contracts, devise and bequeath real and personal property, sue and be sued in all the courts of this state, the same as if he were of the full age of twenty-one years. Authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 251.

[Published April 15, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend section seventy of chapter nineteen of the revised statutes, entitled "of highways, bridges and ferries."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section seventy of chapter nineteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by adding to said section the following words: "And maintain at his or her own expense, a suitable bars or gates through the inclosure over which said road may be laid." Amendment.
