

CHAPTER 240.

[Published May 12, 1865.]

AN ACT to authorize Robert Bretcher and Lina Bretcher to convey certain real estate therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

May convey
real estate.

SECTION 1. That it shall and may be lawful for Robert Bretcher and Lina Bretcher, minors, of the ages of sixteen and thirteen years, of the city of Watertown, and county of Jefferson, to execute a deed of conveyance of any real estate of which they may be now seized, or in which they may have an interest; and every such deed executed in pursuance of this act, shall be as valid and effectual as if the said Robert Bretcher and Lina Bretcher were of full age.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
