

the full term for which he is elected such supervisor, to any office or appointment whatever, to which the election or appointment is authorized to be made by the board of supervisors of which he is a member, nor shall any member of said board of supervisors hold the office of sheriff or deputy sheriff of said county. All elections or appointments, and all votes cast for any person contrary to the provisions of this act, shall be void. Election, &c. declared void.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 281.

[Published May 17, 1865.]

AN ACT relating to property of Indians exempt from taxation, and amendatory of section five of chapter 18, revised statutes, entitled "of the assessment and collection of taxes."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subdivision seven, section four, chapter eighteen, revised statutes, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "The property of all Indians who are not citizens, except lands held by them by purchase, and the personal property of civilized Indians, owning or occupying farms not in an Indian reserve." Exempt from taxation.

SECTION 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.
