

## CHAPTER 103.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 11 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act in relation to records and documentary evidence."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Amended.

Registers' fees for certified copy.

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 11 of the general laws of 1867, entitled "an act in relation to records and documentary evidence," is hereby amended by adding after the last word in the last line of said section two, the following: "and said register shall receive such compensation for making such copy or copies and certifying to the same, as he is now entitled by law to receive for recording deeds and mortgages, which sum shall be paid him on demand by the treasurer of the county in which said registry is made: *provided*, that the office of registry is not a salaried office."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 104.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

AN ACT authorizing the governor to direct concerning the expenditure of certain moneys for the completion of the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Governor may direct expenditure of money.

SECTION 1. The balance of the moneys retained and on deposit with the state treasurer, for the completion of the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers, may be expended for that purpose in such

way and at such times within the period herein prescribed, as the governor of the state shall approve. The time as now limited by law for completing the said improvement by such expenditures is hereby extended one year. The engineer of the improvements shall submit his plans to the governor for his approval. If any change in the plan, as recommended by D. C. Jenne, should be found necessary or advisable, the same may be made with the approval of the governor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 105.

[Published March 9, 1869.]

**AN ACT** to amend sections 1 and 2 of chapter 65 of the revised statutes, [entitled "of the insurance of property in incorporated villages, &c."]

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in its stead: There shall be paid to the treasurer of the fire department of any incorporated city or village in this state, in which there may be a regularly organized fire department, for the use and benefit of said fire department, on the first day of February in each year, by every person who shall act in said city or village as agent for or in behalf of any individual or association, or association of individuals, whether incorporated by the laws of this state or by the laws of any other state, territory or country, to effect insurances against losses or injury by fire, the sum of two dollars upon the hundred dollars, and at that rate upon the amount of all premiums, which, during the year or part of a year ending on the next preceding first day of January, shall have been received by such agent or person, or received by any other person or
