

## CHAPTER 115.

[Published March 25, 1870.]

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 188 of the general laws of 1869, entitled "an act to repeal chapter 452 of the general laws of 1864, entitled 'of counties and county officers,'" and to amend section 51 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes, entitled, "of counties and county officers."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 188 of the general laws of 1869, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 2. Section fifty-one of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word, "law," in the last line of said section, the following words: "No publication of notice of tax sales shall be deemed a legal notice except the same be published in a newspaper printed in the English language, but whenever in the opinion of a court, judge, officer or other person ordering the publication of any other legal notice, the interest of the public and of the parties interested will be subserved thereby, such court, judge, officer or other person shall have authority to order the publication of such notice in some paper printed in other than the English language. If such legal notice shall be so ordered, it shall be published in such newspaper in the English language, and such publication shall be deemed sufficient legal notice." Amended.  
What deemed legal notice of tax sales.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its passage.
