

SECTION 8. The police justice shall quarterly report to the common council a list of all proceedings instituted before him in behalf of said city, and the disposition made thereof, and shall, at the same time, account and pay over to the treasurer the amount of all penalties and fines collected by him, which may by law accrue to said city; said city shall not be liable for or pay any costs in any action or proceeding for violation of any law of this state, but such costs shall be a county charge as heretofore.

Shall make quarterly report.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 195.

AN ACT to restore the right of suffrage to certain citizens of the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter thirty of the general laws of 1866, entitled "an act to amend chapter seven of the revised statutes, entitled of general and special elections; of the manner of conducting the same, and of the canvass;" and all acts amendatory thereof, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
