

**The salaries.** all expenditures except printing of reports. The salary of the chief geologist, (not exceeding three thousand dollars), and the salaries of the assistant geologists shall be fixed by the governor, and shall be for service actually performed, and time actually spent in the work. The balance of the sum hereinbefore appropriated shall be used in such manner as shall best promote the purposes of this act.

**When and where survey to commence.** SECTION 7. The survey shall commence by the first of June next, or as soon thereafter as practicable, beginning with the counties of Ashland and Douglas, and the entire survey shall be completed within four years from and after its commencement.

**Repealed.** SECTION 8. Chapter one hundred and thirty-seven of the general laws of 1870, entitled an act to provide for the survey of the lead district, making maps and collecting statistics and specimens from the same, and chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the general laws of 1872, amendatory thereof, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 293.

[Published March 27, 1873.]

AN ACT regulating the salaries of the judges of the supreme court.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

**Salaries of justices of supreme court.** SECTION 1. The salary of the chief justice and of each of the associate justices of the supreme court of the state of Wisconsin, hereafter elected or appointed, is hereby established at the sum of five thousand dollars per annum; and there is hereby annually appropriated, to be paid out of the state treasury in the manner now provided by law, the sums above named.

SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts contravening this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
