CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to repeal chapter three hundred and [twenty-nine of the laws of Wisconsin for 1876, entitled "An act to authorize the county of Burnett to build and maintain a free bridge across the St. Croix river, in town thirty-eight north, of range twenty west;" also, chapter two hundred and thirty-nine, of the laws of Wisconsin for 1877, amendatory thereof, entitled "An act to amend section one, chapter three hundred and twenty-nine, laws of Wisconsin of 1876, entitled 'An act to authorize the county of Burnett to build and maintain a free bridge across the St. Croix river, in township thirty-eight north, range twenty west.'"]

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and twenty-nine, **Repealed.** laws of Wisconsin for 1876, entitled "An act to authorize the county of Burnett to build and maintain a free bridge across the St. Croix river, in town thirty-eight north, of range twenty west, and chapter two hundred and thirty-nine, laws of Wisconsin for 1877, amendatory thereof, entitled, 'An act to amend section one, chapter three hundred and twenty-nine, laws of Wisconsin of 1876, entitled 'An act to authorize the county of Burnett to build and maintain a free bridge across the St. Croix river, in township thirty-eight north, range twenty west,' " are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 210.

AN ACT to legalize the annual town meeting of the town of Liberty, Outagamie county, Wisconsin, for the year 1877.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The annual town meeting of the town **Legalized.** of Liberty, Outagamie county, Wisconsin, for the year 1877, and all the acts and proceedings of said town meeting, and all the official acts and proceedings of the officers elected at said town meeting, are hereby legal-
