CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT to enlarge and extend the corporate limits of the city of Milwaukee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The corporate limits of the city of Milwaukee are hereby enlarged and extended, so as to include all that part of the northeast quarter of section twenty-five (25), in town seven (7) north, of range twenty-one (21) east, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commencing at a point where the center line of Chestnut street, in said city of Milwaukee, intersects the range line between ranges twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22), running thence west along said center line of said Chestnut street, extended to the west line of the northeast quarter of said section twenty-five (25), thence south along said west line of the northeast quarter of said section twenty-five (25), to the north boundary line of the fourth ward of said city; thence east along said north boundary line of the said fourth ward to a point where the said boundary line intersects the said range line between the said ranges twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22); thence north along said range line to the place of beginning. The territory herein added to said city shall constitute a part of the second ward thereof, and shall be subject to the laws, regulations and ordinances governing the said ward and the said city.

Corporate limits extended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
