CHAPTER 326.

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of school-district number one, of Elkhorn, in Walworth county, had at a special meeting held February fourteenth, eighteen hundred and eighty-seven.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The proceedings of an adjourned special meeting of school-district number one, of the village of Elkhorn, Walworth county, Wisconsin, held at "Wisconsin Hall," in said village, on the fourteenth day of February, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, at which an appropriation was made for the building of a school-house in said district, and authority voted the district board to obtain a loan of money for the purpose of aiding in the erection of such school-house, are hereby legalized and declared to be in all things legal and valid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 327.
