CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to extend the time for holding the charter election in the city of La Crosse, from the first Tuesday in April, 1887, until the third Tuesday in April, 1887.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The charter election of the city of La Crosse, appointed and required to be held on the first Tuesday of April, 1887, is hereby extended and postponed to the third Tuesday in April, 1887, and said charter election shall not be held prior to said third Tuesday of April, 1887. If such postponement will otherwise cause a vacancy in any office in said city, the term of such office shall be extended until such office is filled by appointment or election, or until the office is abolished.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 105.
