CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT fixing the terms of the circuit court for Iowa and La Fayette counties, in the Fifth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The terms of the circuit court for Iowa county shall be held in the year 1893, on the fourth Monday in March and on the fourth Monday in September, and thereafter shall be held on the third Monday in March and the fourth Monday in September in each year. And the terms of the circuit court for La Fayette county shall hereafter be held on the second Tuesday in June and the first Tuesday in December, in each year. Terms of court.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first Monday in May, 1893.

CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT authorizing the Ahnapee and Western railway to build a bridge across Sturgeon Bay.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The Ahnapee and Western railway company, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to build, construct and maintain a bridge for railway purposes, over and across the waters of Sturgeon Bay from any point in township twenty-seven, of range twenty-six east, to any other point in said township in the county of Door, state of Wisconsin; and for Location of bridge.
