CHAPTER 179.

AN ACT authorizing the State Historical Society to sell and convey certain real estate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 54, of the laws of 1893, is hereby amended by striking out the words "go to said society's binding fund," at the close of said section, and substituting therefor the words "be devoted to such purposes as the executive committee of said society may elect," so that said section shall read as follows: "Section 1. The State Historical Society of Wisconsin is hereby authorized to sell and convey certain real estate on West Washington avenue, city of Madison, known as 'the Draper homestead,' being lot number four, block number fifty-one, according to the recorded plat of said city, and the buildings thereon. The proceeds from such sale shall be devoted to such purposes as the executive committee of said society may elect."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
