CHAPTER 259.

AN ACT to amend section 4843, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin, relating to the appointment of agents to receive fugitives from justice, by the governor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4843, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin is hereby amended by adding to the end of said section the following words, to-wit: "Said agent shall receive for his services eight dollars per day for the time necessarily engaged as such agent, and his actual and necessary expenses while acting as such agent, and shall make and present to the county board of said county an itemized verified account, stating the number of days engaged and number of miles traveled, and each item of expense while acting as such agent and no mileage shall be allowed him whatsoever."

Pay of agents who receive fugitives from justice \$8 per day and necessary traveling expenses.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first Monday in January, 1897.
