

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to amend section 669, of the revised statutes relating to the power of the county board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 669, of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a subsection to be numbered and to read as follows: Sub-section 12. In counties having two hundred thousand inhabitants or more according to the last census, to borrow money in any year on or after the first day of July thereof, to pay current expenses of the county, in any sum not exceeding twenty per centum of the amount of the last tax levy for county purposes in any such county, to be repaid with interest not to exceed five per centum per annum on or before the fifteenth day of February then next succeeding, and issue county orders therefor; provided, however, no such sum or sums of money shall be borrowed by any county board under the provisions of this act except it be on the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members thereof.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
