## CHAPTER 144.

**AN ACT** authorizing Frank W. Epley, Henry Floy and George M. Brill to build and maintain a dam across Apple river.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** Frank W. Epley, Henry Floy and George M. Brill and their assigns, are hereby authorized to add to, maintain, reconstruct and repair a dam across Apple river, on the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-five, township thirty-one north, of range nineteen west, of the fourth principal meridian, in the county of St. Croix, said dam to be maintained for the purpose of the improvement of navigation, the manufacture of flour, feed and other milling products and the transmission of electric power; provided that the said dam shall not raise the water to exceed twenty-four feet. This act may be amended or repealed by the legislature at any time hereafter.

Where dam may be maintained. Limitation as to flowage.

**SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
