CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT authorizing the town of Cassville, in Grant county to convey a certain cemetery in said town to the Cassville cemetery association.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The town board of supervisors of Cassville in Grant county Wisconsin is hereby authorized and empowered to grant and convey unto the Cassville cemetery association, an association duly organized under chapter 59 of the revised statutes, a certain cemetery in said town heretofore conveyed to it by one John Geiger and Josephine his wife on January 15th 1866, and being in the southwest quarter, of the northeast quarter, of the southwest quarter, of section sixteen, in town three north, of range five west, in Grant county Wisconsin containing ten acres more or less, by a deed recorded in the office of the register of deeds of said county in book 56 of deeds on page 14, for the use of the inhabitants of said town as a cemetery before the incorporation of the village of Cassville therein as a village, saving and reserving to the inhabitants of said town and village, all their beneficial interests and rights in said cemetery; said association thereafter to keep said cemetery in repair, and suitably protect, improve, manage and control the same for the use of the inhabitants of said town and village as a cemetery, as by the statutes in such case made and provided.

Authorizing town board of supervisors to convey cemetery of ten acres to Cassville cemetery association.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
