CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT to amend section 170 on pages 261 and 262 of Wisconsin statutes of 1898, relating to salaries of employes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Salary of clerk increased.

SECTION 1. Paragraph 9 of page 262 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by striking out the words "one thousand" where they occur in said paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twelve hundred" so that said paragraph when so amended shall read as follows: "A clerk in the office of bank examiner, fifteen hundred dollars; a clerk and stenographer in the office of the bank examiner, twelve hundred dollars."

Scrub women to receive \$1.25 per day.

SECTION 2. Paragraph 1 on page 261 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, is hereby amended by adding the words "and twenty-five cents" after the word "dollar" in line 6 on said page 261, so that the same when amended shall read as follows: "five scrub women at one dollar and twenty-five cents per day for the time during which they are employed."

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
