CHAPTER 323.

AN ACT to amend section 1058 of the Wisconsin statutes, 1898, by striking out the word “copying” in second line thereof. And relating to errors discovered by assessors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1058 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication. Repealing

CHAPTER 324.

AN ACT to provide for an appropriation for the purchase of books for the attorney general's office.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund the sum of two hundred dollars annually, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be expended by the attorney general in the purchase of books for a working library for his department. Appropriating
\$200 annually.
