CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT authorizing and empowering the Wausau Cemetery Association to sell and convey title of certain lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

On reasonable consideration empowered to deed to any purchaser.

SECTION 1. The Wausau Cemetery Association is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey, for a reasonable and adequate consideration, all that part of the southwest quarter, of the northwest quarter of section one, town twenty-eight north, of range seven east, in the county of Marathon, state of Wisconsin, lying west of the public highway known as the Wausau and south line road, to any purchaser or purchasers thereof and to make and to execute, by its president and secretary, a deed in proper form therefor, which deed shall be evidence of a good and sufficient title in fee simple in and to said premises.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
