**CHAPTER 467.**

AN ACT appropriating to Oscar F. Fiebing and Henry J. Killilea, co-partners doing business under the firm name of Fiebing & Killilea, the sum of fifty-nine (\$59.00) dollars.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Appropriation.** SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to Oscar J. Fiebing and Henry J. Killilea, co-partners doing business under the firm name of Fiebing & Killilea, as attorneys for Paul D. Carpenter, the sum of fifty-nine (\$59.00) dollars, the same being in payment of a judgment for costs rendered by the supreme court of the state of Wisconsin in favor of said Paul D. Carpenter and against the state of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

**CHAPTER 468.**

AN ACT to authorize temporary transfer from the general fund to the university fund income.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Transfer authorized.** SECTION 1. The secretary of state, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to transfer, after the beginning of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1905, and before the collection of the tax provided for the support
