**CHAPTER 354**

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums therein named for deficits at the state hospital for the insane, the school for the blind, the industrial school for boys, the home for feeble-minded, the state reformatory, and the state tuberculosis sanatorium.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the state board of control to cover bills incurred and to be incurred at the following institutions from July 1, 1916, to June 30, 1917, not to exceed the following sums:

(a) for the state hospital for the insane, for operation, eleven thousand nine hundred eight dollars; for property repairs and maintenance, two thousand nine hundred twenty-eight dollars.

(b) for the school for the blind, for operation, nine thousand two hundred twenty-nine dollars; for property repairs and maintenance, three thousand five hundred nineteen dollars.

(c) for the industrial school for boys, for operation, ten thousand two hundred sixty-five dollars.

(d) for the home for feeble-minded, for operation, twenty-six thousand six hundred fifty-three dollars; for property repairs and maintenance, three thousand seven hundred twenty-nine dollars.

(e) for the state reformatory, for operation, sixteen thousand nine hundred thirty-two dollars.

(f) for the state tuberculosis sanatorium, for operation, two thousand nine hundred eight dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

**CHAPTER 355**

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 35.31 and subsection (1) of section 20.51 of the statutes, relating to the railroad commission, and making an appropriation.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 35.31 and subsection (1) of section 20.51 of the statutes, are amended to read:

(35.31) (2) The railroad commission shall, quadrennially, present to the printing board printer's copy for a railroad map

of Wisconsin, and the printing board shall thereupon procure the printing of such number thereof unmounted and such number thereof mounted on muslin and provided with rollers as are required for distribution by subsection (13) of section 35.84. *No map shall be prepared, however, during the biennium ending on June 30, 1919.*

(20.51) (1) *On July 1, 1917, one hundred sixty thousand dollars, and annually \* \* \* beginning July 1, \* \* \* 1918 one hundred seventy thousand dollars, for administration and the execution of its general functions. Of this there is allotted to each member of said commission an annual salary of five thousand dollars.*

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.

## CHAPTER 356

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money therein named to the state council of defense for the establishment of special courses for intensified training of attendants of the sick.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the state council of defense not to exceed the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, for the purpose of establishing, under its supervision, special courses for intensified training of attendants of the sick, through the establishment of scholarships, and by such other means as the council may deem advisable. Such scholarship shall be granted only upon the condition that the persons receiving the same shall agree to engage in practical nursing in this state for a period of two years following the completion of the special courses for which such scholarships are granted.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
