

exceed twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars and shall not exceed a like amount for the fiscal year ending June 30, \* \* \* 1927. Of this there is allotted to each member of said board a per diem of ten dollars for each day actually devoted to the performance of the duties of said board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1925.

## CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to amend subsections (2) and (3) of section 20.35 of the statutes, relating to maintenance and capital for the Wisconsin mining school, and making an appropriation.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 20.35 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.35) (2) On July 1, \* \* \* 1925, \* \* \* *four thousand two hundred ten* dollars and on July 1, \* \* \* 1926, three thousand \* \* \* *five hundred* \* \* \* *ten* dollars, for property repairs and maintenance.

(3) On July 1, \* \* \* 1925, \* \* \* *four thousand three hundred ninety* dollars; on July 1, \* \* \* 1926, \* \* \* *two thousand eight hundred* \* \* \* *fifty* dollars, for furniture and furnishings; educational apparatus, library and reference books, and other permanent property and improvements; except for the purchase of land \* \* \*.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1925.
