CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT to amend subsections (4), (5), (10), and (13) of section 20.43 of the statutes relating to ophthalmia neonatorum, venereal diseases, sanitary control of waters of the state, and the bureau of child welfare in the department of the State Board of Health, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsections (4), (5), (10), and (13) of section 20.43 of the statutes are amended to read: (Section 20.43) (4) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1925, one thousand five hundred dollars, for prevention of ophthalmia neonatorum, and preparation and distribution of nitrate of silver therefor, as provided in section 146.01 subsection (1).

(5) * * * Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1925, thirty-six thousand three hundred seventy dollars, * * * for the prevention and control of venereal diseases. All moneys paid into the state treasury by the United States for that purpose are appropriated to the state board of health and vital statistics to be expended therefor, but the amount of the appropriations herein of state funds shall be diminished by the amounts so received from the United States.

(10) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1925, * * * fourteen thousand dollars to carry out the provisions of sections 144.01 to 144.12.

(13) On July 1, * * * 1925, twenty-three thousand dollars, and on July 1, * * * 1926, twenty-three thousand dollars for the establishment and operation of a bureau of child welfare and public health nursing.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1925.
