CHAPTER 440.

AN ACT to add two additional members to the school board of the Red Granite Joint School District No. 1 in Waushara county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The school board of the Red Granite Joint School District No. 1 in Waushara county shall consist of a director, treasurer, and clerk, and two additional members hereby added to said board. Such additional members shall be elected at the annual school meeting on the second Monday of July, 1931, and one of such additional members first chosen shall be elected for a term to expire on the second Monday of July, 1932, and the other for a term to expire on the second Monday of July, 1933. On expiration of these terms their successors shall be elected for a term of three years expiring on the second Monday of July. The director, treasurer and clerk shall continue to serve for the same terms as heretofore.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 441.

AN ACT relating to the wages of employes of sewerage commission in certain counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners of the metropolitan sewerage commission created by chapter 554 of the laws of 1921 and the commissioners of the sewerage commission created by chapter 608 of the laws of 1913 operating in counties which have a population of five hundred thousand or more, shall establish a minimum wage scale for all employes and laborers of such commissions which shall not be less than the prevailing wage paid to similar employes of the county and municipalities of such county. The commissioners of such commissions shall insert in all con-

tracts for work to be done for the commissions a provision requiring that a minimum wage scale be paid by contractors on all work done for such commissions, which minimum wage scale so established shall not be less than the prevailing wage scale paid by contractors doing work for the county and municipalities of such county.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this act in so far as they affect the commissioners of the sewerage commission created by chapter 608 of the laws of 1913 shall take effect upon passage and publication. The provisions of this act affecting the commissioners of the metropolitan sewerage commission created by chapter 554 of the laws of 1921 shall take effect January 1, 1932.

CHAPTER 442.

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 37.11 of the statutes, relating to the board of normal school regents, to reconcile this subsection with the provisions of chapter 185, laws of 1931.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 37.11 of the statutes is amended to read: (37.11) (3) To remove at pleasure any principal, assistant or other officer or person from any office or employment in connection with any such school, *but discharges of teachers shall be governed by the provisions of section 37.31.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

AN ACT to extend for one month the time for the payment of income taxes in 1931.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
