**CHAPTER 252.**

AN ACT to create 5.05 (7) of the statutes, relating to placing a candidate in nomination on more than one party ticket at the same primary.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

5.05 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

5.05 (7) No filing officer shall accept nomination papers for any candidate to run in more than one party primary at the same time.

**CHAPTER 253.**

AN ACT to amend 74.135 (introductory paragraph) and to create 74.135 (5) and (6) of the statutes, relating to the cancellation of taxes by the governing bodies of towns, cities and villages.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 74.135 (introductory paragraph) of the statutes is amended to read:

74.135 (Introductory paragraph) After the tax roll shall have been thus delivered to the treasurer it shall not be lawful for the \* \* \* *governing body of any town, city or village* to remit, annul or cancel any tax specified therein except in the following cases:

SECTION 2. 74.135 (5) and (6) of the statutes are created to read:

74.135 (5) When a double assessment has been made.

(6) When a palpable error had been made in the assessment, in which case the error may be corrected.
