**CHAPTER 341.**

AN ACT to amend 85.141 (6) (a) of the statutes, relating to reporting certain accidents and providing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

85.141 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.141 (6) (a) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of any person or total property damage to an apparent extent of \$50 or more shall \* \* \* within 10 days, report such accident \* \* \* *if it occurred within any city of the first, second, third and fourth class to the police department and if it occurred outside of any such city, to the sheriff's office or to the traffic department of the county* and within 10 days after such accident, forward a written report of such accident to the state motor vehicle department.
