CHAPTER 209.

AN ACT to amend 24.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to sale of state public lands to counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

24.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

24.09 (1) All public lands that have been heretofore appraised or appraised pursuant to section 24.08, shall, from time to time in the discretion of said commissioners, be offered

for sale at public auction, except: that lands required for state *or county* use may be sold to *counties or* other state departments, boards or commissions at the appraised value * * * and except that lands located within the exterior boundaries of Indian reservations may be sold to the Indian tribe or tribes located on such reservations or to the United States for the benefit and use of such tribe or tribes upon prices, terms and conditions agreeable to said commissioners and without being subject to the restrictions and procedure otherwise provided by law for the sale of public lands. All sales other than to *counties*, state agencies or to the United States or an Indian tribe or tribes, as hereinbefore provided, shall be made at such times and public places as said commissioners shall designate; and they shall, previous to any such sale, cause a notice specifying such time and place and describing the lands to be sold, to be published once in each week for 3 successive weeks in one newspaper printed in the county where such lands are situated; but if there be no such newspaper, then in the newspaper printed nearest to the place where such lands are situated.
