CHAPTER 498.

AN ACT to create 16.541 of the statutes, relating to civil service in cities of the first class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

16.541 of the statutes is created to read:

16.541 CIVIL SERVICE TO INCLUDE STENOGRAPHIC AND CLERICAL EMPLOYES IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY. The expression "members of the law, fire and police departments" as used in section 16.54 and as used in any charter ordinance in any city of the first class which may supersede, amend, extend or modify said section for said city, shall be held to include all employes of the law department of such city who are members of the bar engaged in legal duties but shall not be held to include clerks, stenographers, typists or other employes of the law department who are not members of the bar.
