CHAPTER 528.

AN ACT to amend 97.02 (5) (c) of the statutes, relating to marketing skim milk as fat-free milk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

97.02 (5) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

97.02 (5) (c) Skim milk is milk from which a part or all of the cream has been removed, and contains not less than 8½ per cent of milk solids. *It may be offered for sale and sold as "Fat Free Milk" if the milk fat content does not exceed twenty-five one-hundredths of one per cent and the words "Skim Milk" printed on the container.*
