CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT to amend 316.35 of the statutes, relating to deed for land contract in probate matters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

316.35 of the statutes is amended to read:

316.35 On the presentation of a petition by the executor or administrator, general or special, or by any person claiming to be entitled to such conveyance from any executor or administrator, or by any person interested in the real estate sought to be deeded or the title thereto, setting forth the facts upon which the petition is predicated, the court * * * may appoint a time and place * * * for hearing * * * and * * * order notice * * * thereof to be given as provided in section 324.18 or the court may, in its discretion, upon finding that there are no objections, direct execution of a deed in accordance with the contract, without hearing or notice.
