**CHAPTER 543.**

AN ACT to amend 20.01 (6) (a) of the statutes, relating to increasing the number of assembly subordinate clerks.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

20.01 (6) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.01 (6) (a) \* \* \* *Thirteen* legislative clerks, who shall assist the chief clerk in maintaining the official records of proceedings of the assembly, index, revise and enroll bills, maintain mailing lists, and perform such other work as may be required, \$7 per day. Two of said clerks shall be assigned to the revising and enrolling of bills and shall have some knowledge of and experience in proof reading as evidenced by such tests as the bureau of personnel may require ~~and one of whom shall be assigned to the operation of the voting machine and who shall receive \$1 a day more than the amount stipulated for legislative clerks in this paragraph.~~
