CHAPTER 152

AN ACT to amend 100.06 (1) (a) and (2) (intro. par.) of the statutes, relating to excepting certain groups from the dairy plant and receiving station financial condition law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 100.06 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

100.06 (1) (a) No person shall operate a dairy plant or receiving station, as defined in s. 97.04, and no license therefor shall be issued unless he shall have first satisfied the department that his financial condition is such as to reasonably assure prompt payment to the producers for the milk and cream to be * * * *purchased* by him as and when the same becomes due and payable * * * .

SECTION 2. 100.06 (2) (intro. par.) of the statutes is amended to read:

100.06 (2) (intro. par.) In all cases where it appears that the financial condition of the applicant or of the licensee is not adequate to reasonably assure payment when due for the milk, cream or dairy products to be purchased * * * by him, the department may require:
