

**CHAPTER 153**

AN ACT to create 41.01 (5d) of the statutes, relating to the admission of children, with sight defects, to kindergartens.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

41.01 (5d) of the statutes is created to read:

41.01 (5d) A municipality may with the approval of the state superintendent transport and pay the tuition, for handicapped children with sight defects, to day classes for kindergarten pupils in a school district providing training for such children other than the district of residence, provided the district of residence maintains no such classes. Such tuition charges shall be made in accordance with sub. (5).
