### CHAPTER 193

AN ACT to amend 325.06 (1) of the statutes, relating to prepayment of witness fees.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

325.06 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

325.06 (1) Except when subpoenaed on behalf of the state, no person shall be obliged to attend as a witness in any civil action, matter or

proceeding unless his fees are paid or tendered to him for one day's attendance and for travel; *provided that tender of witness fees in the form of a check drawn by the state, a political subdivision of the state, a municipal corporation of the state or a department or officer of any of them which is payable to bearer or payable to the order of the person named in such subpoena shall oblige the person named in such subpoena to attend as a witness in accordance with the lawful requirements of such subpoena.*
