CHAPTER 229

AN ACT to create 20.005 (2) (a) (line 499) and 20.551 (1a) of the statutes, relating to an appropriation for advertising recreational facilities of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (2) (a) (line 499) of the statutes is created to read:

499. Advertising Wisconsin	-----	20.551 (1a)	1957-58 1958-59 \$103,100 \$103,100

SECTION 2. 20.551 (1a) of the statutes is created to read:

20.551 (1a) TRANSFER TO CONSERVATION FUND; ADVERTISING WISCONSIN. Annually beginning July 1, 1957, \$103,100 to the conservation fund for the execution of its functions under s. 23.09 (7) (L).

SECTION 3. Section 20.280 (74) of the statutes as affected by the laws of 1957, is increased by adding the following amount:

Conservation Commission

for the purpose of providing increased funds for recreational advertising and publicity.
