**CHAPTER 249**

AN ACT to create chapter 308, laws of 1955, section 1 (3m), relating to appointing a justice of the peace to act as judge in certain matters within the additional jurisdiction of the county court of Clark county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Chapter 308, laws of 1955, section 1 (3m) is created to read:

(Chapter 308, laws of 1955) SECTION 1. (3m) In case the presiding judge of said county court shall, on account of sickness, absence, disability or disqualification for any cause, be disabled from presiding in the trial of any action or proceeding enumerated in subsection (3), he may by an order in writing, filed in said court, appoint any justice of the peace of said county to discharge during such sickness, absence, disability or disqualification the duties of said office conferred by subsection (3), to

preside and hold court in his stead; and such person so appointed shall possess and exercise all of the powers granted therein and shall be compensated at the rate of \$7.50 per half day, payable out of the county treasury on certificate of the county judge.
