CHAPTER 302

AN ACT to amend 205.18 of the statutes, relating to classification and survey of risks with reference to insurance under the workmen's compensation law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

205.18 of the statutes is amended to read:

205.18 The bureau shall assign each compensation risk and subdivision thereof to its proper class. Such classification shall be subject to the approval of the commissioner, and shall bind all companies when approved. The bureau shall on behalf of all members inspect and make a written survey of each risk. It shall file with the commissioner its classification of risks and the written surveys of all risks inspected by it, showing charges and credits, and such other facts as are material in the writing of insurance thereon. It shall file any subsequent proposed classification or later survey and all rules and regulations which may affect the writing of such risks. * * * *The bureau shall make available to all companies information as to classifications, rates, surveys and other pertinent facts in accordance with rules established by the bureau and approved by the commissioner.*
