### CHAPTER 318

AN ACT to amend 36.16 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to remission of fees for nonresident students at the university.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

36.16 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.16 (1) (d) The regents of the university may remit nonresident tuition either in whole or in part but not other fees, to a number of needy and worthy nonresident students, not exceeding 8 per cent of the number of nonresident students registered in the preceding year, upon the basis of merit, to be shown by suitable tests, examinations or scholastic records and continued high standards of scholastic attainments. *The board may remit nonresident tuition in whole or in part, but no other fees, to additional individual students at the university not exceeding 2 per cent of the number of nonresident students registered in the preceding year who, in the judgment of the board, are entitled to equitable relief from the assessment of nonresident tuition.*
