CHAPTER 35

AN ACT to create 93.02 (8) (b) of the statutes, relating to the appointment of a deputy director for the state department of agriculture.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

93.02 (8) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

93.02 (8) (b) The director, with approval of the board, may appoint a deputy director, who is not subject to the provisions of ch. 16. The head of a division created under sub. (9) may be selected as deputy director. The appointment of a person subject to ch. 16 shall not affect his status under the classified civil service. In the absence or disability of the director, the deputy may do and perform all the acts provided by statute to be performed by the director, and shall perform such other duties as the director prescribes. The director is responsible for all acts of his deputy. Before entering upon his duties the deputy shall take and file the oath of office required of the director.
